REPEAL BYLAW

- 1.0** Subject to Section 3 of this Bylaw, from and after the date upon which these Bylaws shall be approved by the Minister of Municipal Affairs, all existing Bylaws of the Town shall cease to have force and effect and are hereby repealed.
- 2.0** Notwithstanding Section 1 of this Bylaw, any violation of any Bylaw of the Town arising before the date of approval of these Bylaws shall be enforced by the Town as if this Bylaw had not been approved by the Minister of Municipal Affairs and any assessment, rate, charge, tax, fee, liability, fine, or penalty outstanding under any existing Bylaw of the Town may be collected by the Town as if this Bylaw had not been approved by the Minister of Municipal Affairs.
- 3.0** Notwithstanding any Section of this Bylaw, the following Bylaws, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect, as if not repealed:
 - a. Boundaries Bylaw, except Section 2 thereof;
 - b. Zoning Bylaw, adopted on the 30 day of August, 1977; approved by the Minister of Municipal Affairs for the province of Nova Scotia on October 5, 1977, together with all amendments thereto, as listed on Schedule "A" attached to this Bylaw;
 - c. Subdivision Bylaw;
 - d. Collection, Storage, and Disposal of Garbage Bylaw, adopted by Council on March 11, 1982, and approved by the Minister of Municipal Affairs for the Province of Nova Scotia, on April 21, 1982;
 - e. Heritage Property Bylaw, adopted by Council on March 11, 1982, and approved by the Minister of Municipal Affairs for the Province of Nova Scotia on April 21, 1982;
 - f. Noise Bylaw, adopted by Council on March 11, 1982, and adopted by the Minister of Municipal Affairs for the Province of Nova Scotia on November 26, 1980;
 - g. Parking Tax Assessment Area bylaw, adopted by Council on November 10, 1980 and approved by the Minister of Municipal Affairs for the Province of Nova Scotia on November 26, 1980.
 - h. Taxi bylaw adopted by Council on July 9, 1976 and approved by the Minister of Municipal Affairs on July 22, 1976 and an amendment approved by the Minister of Municipal Affairs on February 13, 1981.
