ON SITE SERVICING BYLAW

Effective: March 23, 2001

Pursuant to subsection 172(1)(a) and 220(5)(n) of the *Municipal Government Act*. Resolved as a bylaw of the Town of Yarmouth that:

- 1.0** No person shall develop or construct a dug well within the Town of Yarmouth except on a lot on which a dug well exists as of the date of this bylaw.
- 2.0** No person shall develop or construct a drilled well except:
 - a. In areas explicitly permitted to use on-site sewer and water services pursuant to the Town's Municipal Planning Strategy and Land Use Bylaw; or
 - b. On a lot on which a drilled well exists as of the date of this bylaw.
- 3.0** No person shall develop or construct an on-site sewage disposal system except:
 - a. In areas explicitly permitted to use on-site sewer and water services pursuant to the Town's Municipal Planning Strategy and Land Use Bylaw; or
 - b. On a lot on which an on-site sewage disposal system exists as of the date of this bylaw.
- 4.0** Any on-site sewage disposal system permitted under this bylaw shall be constructed and maintained in compliance with the regulations respecting on-site sewage disposal systems made by the Governor in Council pursuant to Section 66 and other regulation-making Sections of Chapter 1 of the Revised Statutes of Nova Scotia, 1994-95, the *Environment Act*.
